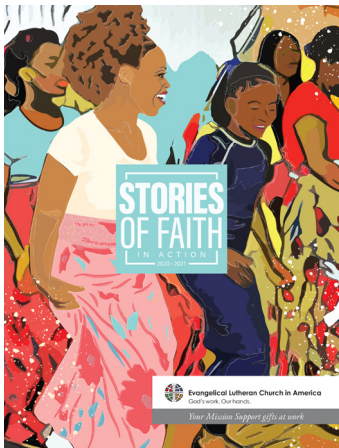

In his letter to the Christians at Ephesus (Ephesians 4:1-7, 11-16), the apostle Paul makes seven references to the word “one,” reflecting the importance of being called into the “unity of Christ.” While the members of this young faith community were Jews and Gentiles from several ethnicities and nationalities, they were taught to believe in “one Lord, one faith, one baptism.” Paul also invited these early Christians to recognize the different gifts given to each person by God and to consider these as gifts to build up the whole community.

These gifts were to equip and support God’s work, and for “building up the body of Christ.” Today we too are connected in the same body of Christ. We enable and support each other to grow in faith and to put our faith into action. One way we are connected is the regular offerings shared by members and friends with your congregation. These are a gift to be used for ministry in your congregation and as Mission Support for your synod and churchwide ministries. Whether your congregation is a young one beginning its journey or one that has grown in stature through Christ, we are knit together to “promote the body’s growth

in building itself up in love.” We invite you to share in the grace given to your congregation by building up the portion of your regular offerings shared as Mission Support.
