Overview: This position's primary role is to work with the Pastor, congregation, and church staff to coordinate the musical needs of the church ranging from music performed before, during, and after the services, music performed for online services, and providing opportunities for musical engagement outside of services. The musical needs of the church will include various musical styles including contemporary, traditional, a capella, instrumental *obbligatos*, or other variations.

Services

- Provide / Organize quality music before, during, and following each worship service
- Collaborate with pastor select music for all services of worship including funerals and weddings
- Coordinate a variety of professional and lay soloists, ensembles, and choirs to provide worshippers the opportunity to be uplifted by the musical offerings
- Create musical settings to coincide with church liturgical calendar
- Plan and coordinate musicians for in-person and online worship services

Communication

- Articulate needs of services to church administration clearly
- Attend weekly staff meetings and one on ones with supervising pastor
- Lead seasonal congregational choirs (or work with a choir director) to coordinate a fair and reasonable community spirit that is open to everyone.

Requirements

- A demonstrated mastery of keyboard techniques or guitar.
- A clear openness and interest in diverse musical styles, forms, and performers

Accountability

- This position will be supervised by the Lead Pastor
- This position will need to be open to congregational and community feedback
- Must accept the provisions of CLC's Personnel Policies

Hours

- 25 hours weekly
- Attend weekly staff or other on-site meetings as requested
- 1-2 services per week that may increase seasonally. (Advent, Christmas and Lent)
