**Purpose**

To direct the ministry of the Praise Band in leading and supporting the worship life of the congregation

**Major Responsibilities and Tasks**

**Leadership**

- Lead the Praise Band in worship services on Sunday mornings and special occasions
- Lead rehearsal in preparation for Sunday and special worship services
- Choose music for worship services based upon the liturgical calendar and the specific themes expressed in the pastor's planning documents
- Support Praise Band members by creating an environment in which each member shares their gifts, nurtures their faith, and experiences joy and fulfillment in this ministry

**Administration**

- Develop and organize a body of appropriate music for the Praise Band's use
- Attend planning meetings as requested
- Consult with the pastor and congregation treasurer on preparation of an annual budget for Praise Band needs
- Maintain all necessary copyright agreements for worship music
- Prepare projection slides for worship services, as appropriate

**Supervision**

The pastor will supervise and evaluate the performance of the person in this position and will retain final approval for all music

**General Information**

This is a part-time position, not benefits-eligible, set at a base of 6 hours per week, with additional time as necessary for special events and projects.

**Job Requirements**

Bachelor's degree in Music or related field preferred

3+ years of experience leading worship services preferred

Knowledge of operation of an audio mixing board helpful but not required, including ability to troubleshoot for sound tech problems

Proficiency with musical instruments

Knowledge of different styles of music, such as traditional, contemporary, and gospel

Excellent leadership and communication skills

Ability to work collaboratively with other team members

Ability to effectively lead and engage a congregation in worship

Christian behavior in all interactions and areas of job responsibility

**Physical Requirements**

Ability to stand or sit and perform using a musical instrument

Ability to move up and down in the chancel area

Ability to climb stairs to access the choir loft

Ability to lift/push 30-50 pounds
