



COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR CONSTRUCTION VOLUNTEERS

Habitat for Humanity of Orange County is committed to the safety of our volunteers, staff, and the families we serve. Due to the seriousness of COVID-19, we have implemented policies and procedures to help ensure everyone's safety. Should you choose to volunteer with us, we require that you adhere to the following guidelines:

DO NOT volunteer if in the last 14 days you have:

- Experienced symptoms that could be related to COVID-19
- Tested positive for COVID-19, or been around anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

We also recommend that you **DO NOT** volunteer if you, anyone you live with, or anyone you are in frequent contact with is considered to be in the higher-risk categories for the virus.

All volunteers are required to provide their own facemasks. Individuals without a facemask will not be permitted to volunteer.

Besides facemasks and proper footwear, volunteers must provide their own gloves. If volunteers have them, they are also encouraged to bring their own safety goggles and hardhats.

Please allow for extra time at check-in for temperature scan and health screening.

While volunteering, you must practice the following universal infection control precautions:

- Use proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) at all times (masks and gloves)
- Clean and wash your hands for a minimum of 20 seconds before, during, and after volunteering
- Avoid physical contact with others and maintain a social distance of 6 feet whenever possible
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue, or the inside of your elbow
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands

Clean and sanitize any tools and equipment after every use. Eliminate the use of shared tools and equipment as much as possible.

DO NOT take part in any task if you are uncomfortable with the level of risk. Talk to a Habitat OC staff member immediately if you feel uncomfortable at any point.

Understand that volunteer shift times and capacities are subject to change with limited notice. It is up to Habitat OC staff discretion of to determine capacity for the safety of all.

Regularly refer to the CDC's website for information and updates on COVID-19.

Any volunteer that begins showing symptoms of COVID-19 must leave immediately.
