



Trinity High School will be collecting items for the annual Thanksgiving Food Drive from November 9 to November 16. This year our community partner, Marillac St. Vincent, has asked us to collect items for “bakery bags.” Around the holidays, many families receive what you normally would imagine from a food pantry - a turkey, sides, and bread - but they often don’t get the supplies needed to bake a special dessert. What we collect as a community will fill this need and give families the opportunity to bake that delicious pie or the family’s favorite dessert for the holidays!

The school-wide goal is 100 bags. To encourage participation, students will compete in lunch circles to assemble bakery bags. Each lunch circle that completes 3 bags will be entered into a raffle. All students will be entered into a separate raffle for each item they collect. All e-learners are encouraged to participate with their lunch circle or are welcome to drop off items at the front office and be entered into the all-student raffle.

Students should work with their lunch circle to know what item(s) to bring. At this time, we are only collecting items for bakery bags. One bag includes:

- 1 bag of all-purpose flour
- 1 bag of sugar
- 1 carton of baking soda
- 1 can of baking powder
- 1 container of table salt
- 1 bag/box of cornmeal
- 1 bottle of vanilla extract

Marillac St. Vincent has seen a 43% increase in brand-new clients to their food pantries since the pandemic began in March.
