Screening Entries Update:

As a reminder, starting Block 2 tomorrow, November 2, 2020, we have a slight adjustment to our entrances. Here are the new locations by last name:

- EARLY ENTRANCE-- Students who arrive early (starting at 7:00 am) may report to the SMG prior to their 7:55 admittance time
- ENTRANCE 1-- Lathrop North: Students A-G
- ENTRANCE 2-- Lathrop Main: Students H-Q
- ENTRANCE 3-- Division/Chapel: Students R-Z
- ENTRANCE 4--SMGAF (Circle Drive): Students with first period in SMGAF
- Reminder: Students will not be permitted into the building before 7:55 and must depart the building no later than 3:30 pm

Uniform Update:

As you know, starting Block 2 tomorrow, November 2, 2020, all students are expected to return to full uniform. Uniforms should have been ordered from our [Schoolbelles Trinity High School Shopping Page](#) (code S1350).

Due to the necessity of air circulation because of COVID-19, we are adjusting the uniform code slightly to adjust to what will be colder learning spaces due to open windows.

Students will still be required to wear a uniform top and bottom. However, the following permissions will be allowed:

- Schoolbelles pants instead of the skirt are always an option, but a solid-color non-uniform pants/leggings under the skirt will also be permitted. Tights and nylons are also still permitted.
- Jackets/coats and Trinity-wear sweatshirts will be permissible over the uniform shirt (polo or oxford). The Schoolbelles sweater and quarter-zip are also still permitted. Students will still not have access to lockers for Block 2, and so will be carrying their coats/jackets with them to class.



- Winter boots will be permitted to help their feet stay warm. If not opting to wear boots, students should wear dress codes shoes. Backless shoes, slippers, gym shoes, canvas shoes (like vans and chuck taylors) and sandals are still not permitted.
- Students may wear scarves, hats and gloves/mittens if necessary. These exceptions are for the warmth and health of our Blazers. Baseball caps, or other non-winter apparel, will still not be permitted.

Trinity's dress code also consists of the following:

- Students must have School ID on them at all times
- NO EARBUDS/NO HEADPHONES may be worn without permission from their teachers and may not be worn in the hallways
- Any student coming to school with visible body piercings other than ear piercings will be asked to remove the jewelry and the jewelry will be confiscated.
- Hair colors must be limited to those colors which are genetically possible. Any student with unacceptable hair color will be required to remedy the issue before returning to school.
