Dear Parent/Guardian of Freshmen and Sophomores:

Trinity's Winter Rose Dance is scheduled for Friday, February 21, 2020 and will be held in the school (small) gym from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. All students are expected to arrive no later than 7:30 and must remain at the dance until at least 9:30 pm. All students who are attending the dance must be in school on February 21th for the entire day. Each student is allowed to bring up to 3 guests and must have a completed permission form including information for each guest. This is a semi-formal dance and proper dress attire is required. Sweats, jeans, denim, leisure clothes, bare midriffs and low cut tops are not appropriate. Trinity students and their guests must present their high school I.D. at the door.

We wish to be very clear about the consequences of infractions of the Student Handbook forbidding alcohol or drugs:

The use or evidence of drugs, marijuana or alcohol at Trinity High School or any school-sponsored function by students and/or their guests is absolutely forbidden. Any violation will result in strong disciplinary action, including possible dismissal from school. Should your student's behavior indicate any consumption of drugs or alcohol, you will be called to come to take your student and her guest(s) home. Your student will be suspended from school until a meeting can be arranged between you, your student and the Administration. Should your student's guest(s) indicate that he/she has consumed alcohol or drugs, the police will be notified and you will be called.

In addition, we do not condone or endorse pre or post-dance parties at hotels or private homes, especially where alcohol may be served. The dance is supervised by school personnel from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Please be aware of your student's plans for the evening. We encourage you to take advantage of the opportunity before the dance to engage in a serious conversation with your student about these important matters.

All detentions must be served before dance tickets are purchased and any student attends the dance. We know you understand that school policies are made with the best interests of your student in mind. We ask that you sign the form below indicating your support of and cooperation with this policy. This form must be returned when your student buys a ticket for herself and up to 3 guests. The cost of the dance is \$15.00 per person. Tickets will be sold February 18-21st during 3B in the cafeteria.
