Dear Parents/Guardians,

For the 2020-2021 school year, Illinois state law requires that any child entering the 12th grade must show proof of having received two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine prior to entering the 12th grade. The first dose shall have been received on or after the 11th birthday, and the second dose shall have been received on or after the 16th birthday, at least eight weeks after the first dose. If the first dose is administered when the child is 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required.

Please speak with your child's healthcare provider over the summer regarding your child's vaccination needs. Trinity High School must have documentation of when the vaccine was administered in order for your child to be in compliance with State of Illinois requirements.

Proof of receiving the meningitis vaccine must be on file by October 15, 2020 or your student will be excluded from school until proof of the health examination and the required immunizations has been presented.

If a physician appointment is needed and unable to be obtained before the due date, please send verification of the appointment from the doctor to the Trinity Main Office.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Your student's health and the health of our Trinity community are of utmost importance. Please contact me should you have any questions.
