On May 12th, check-in will be from 8:00 am-8:15 am and testing will begin promptly at 8:15 am. Your daughter should report to the following entrances based on the first letter of her last name:

(A-L)- Check-in at the main entrance on Lathrop Avenue
(M-Z)- Check-in at the Division Street entrance

If your student is an e-learner and is struggling to get the Appian App to work, she may print this [form](#) to present with a parent signature at check-in instead of using the app. Testing will conclude at 2:55 and students will be dismissed at this time. Buses will run according to the regular schedule. Lastly, students will need to bring the following with on test day, #2 pencils, a calculator, and a bag lunch.
