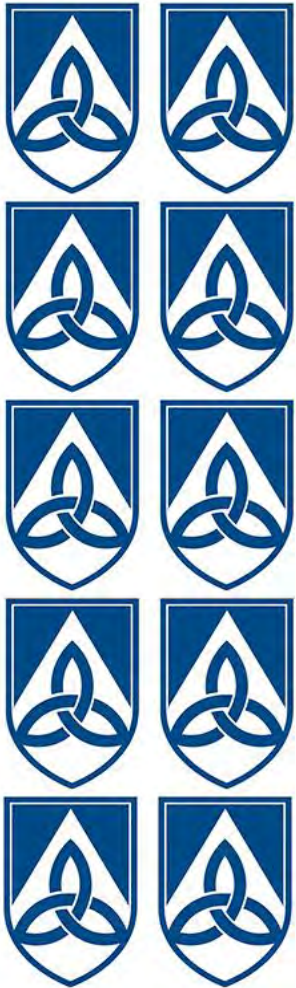

Each student is recognized as unique.

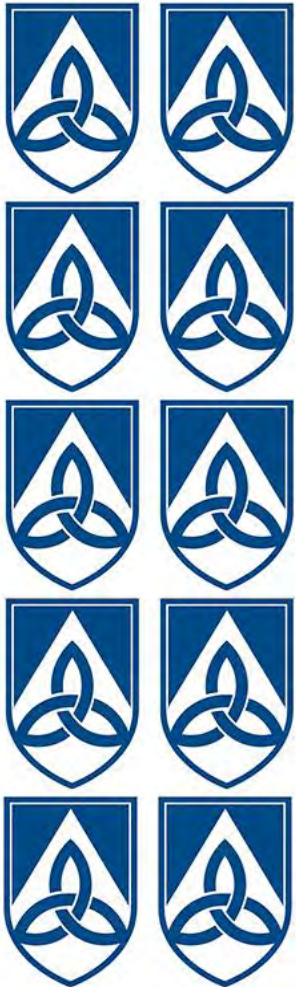
