Dear Trinity Parents and Guardians,

We are grateful to you for choosing to send your student to Trinity High School and entrusting her to our care for four very significant years of her life. Trinity has been committed to excellence in the education of young women for over one hundred years, and this past year has been one of the most challenging. Regardless of the challenges our teachers face, your student, like the generations of talented alumnae before her, will leave Trinity prepared for success in college and beyond. Next school year will be our 104th year in operation, and we are thrilled that you will be part of our family again.

Shortly, your daughter will be meeting with her counselor and choosing classes for next year. With a traditional class schedule, most high school students earn twenty to twenty-four credits over four years. With our block schedule, your child earns a minimum of twenty-eight credit hours with an option of earning up to thirty-two credits with no additional course fees/tuition. Please make certain to discuss her choices with her. We know that a home support system is an integral part of a successful Trinity woman, so we appreciate you continuing to be hands-on with her education.

Education expenses, like everything else, continue to rise. Tuition for the 2021-2022 school year will be \$14,500. Tuition covers approximately 80% of the actual cost per student; the remaining is filled through student fundraisers, the Pledge for Blazer Excellence Program, and the generosity of our alumnae, parents and friends of Trinity High School. **The Trinity Financial Aid application is now open, and the priority deadline is tomorrow, January 18, 2021.** (www.trinityhs.org/admissions/tuition--financial-aid)

Finally, on the reverse of this letter you will find the tentative schedule for the 2021-2022 academic year. Specifics of exam dates, teacher institute days and other dates of significance will be finalized in the coming months. You can expect the full calendar shortly after spring break.
