

Timothy D. Fitzgerald, CFA, FHFMA Professional Biography



Timothy D. Fitzgerald is vice president, treasury and financial systems of Geisinger. He joined Geisinger in October 2000. His current responsibilities include debt, investments, cash management, accounts payable, payroll, workforce management, financial systems and tax. Mr. Fitzgerald advises executive management on capital markets, valuations and mergers & acquisitions. He participates in the Geisinger's technology transfer and commercialization activities.

Prior to his current position, he was employed by PNC Bank and predecessor organizations for 18 years, most recently in the healthcare and public finance service line. Founded more than 100 years ago by Abigail Geisinger, Geisinger operates in 45 of Pennsylvania's 67 counties, with a significant presence in central, south-central and northeastern Pennsylvania, outside the major metropolitan areas, and in 7 counties in southern New Jersey. For the twelve-month period ended June 30, 2020, Geisinger cared for a unique population of approximately 1,363,000 people. Unique population is comprised of approximately 1,144,000 patients receiving care in the trailing twelve months and nearly 545,000 GHPs members as of June 30, 2020. Unique population included almost 326,000 people who were both Geisinger patients and members.
