

THE PURPOSE OF CAMP

The purpose of the Higher Level Father-Son Basketball Camp is to provide fathers and guardians a time to spend with their sons in a setting that allows them quality time without the disruptions of home. The camp is designed to teach fundamentals of basketball to the sons and to give the fathers a chance to participate in these teaching techniques. The camp will provide for time on the courts, as well as "time-out" sessions for Bible study, guest speakers, chapel time for worship and free time to swim, play frisbee or just be together. The goal of the camp is to bring fathers and their sons into a life changing relationship that will last forever.

WHO CAN ATTEND CAMP?

Any son who is in the first through the eighth grade is eligible to attend camp. Any father who can tie on a pair of tennis shoes and pick up a basketball is eligible for camp. The skill levels are not important as our goal is to teach the fundamentals of the game. Students will be divided into groups of similar age and ability.

DATES AND LOCATIONS

The Higher Level Father-Son Basketball Camps will be held at Anderson University. Beginning on Friday evening and running through Sunday at noon, the camp is designed so that the fathers will only have to miss a minimum of work. Each father and son will be housed in a private room in a dorm near the Gymnasium. The swimming pool, the game room and the athletic fields will all be available for use during the camp. Meals are provided on campus by food services at the university.

CAMP THEME

The camp theme this year is "PREPARED AND READY", based on Ephesians 4:12-13. All of the fathers and sons will be encouraged to be "PREPARED AND READY" to face the important things in life that they will be facing in the future. We will discuss the challenges of being a husband and father in today's society and the Christian's response to those challenges. Also, we will look into the best ways to prepare your son for his future to be able to live a dynamic Christian lifestyle. We will look at the athletic experiences of your son and how those can be used to teach him how to be "PREPARED AND READY" as he grows older. The hope of the Higher Level staff is that all of the fathers and sons will leave camp with a bonding and life changing experience that they will cherish for the rest of their lives. Our desire is that everyone in camp will be "PREPARED AND READY" for their future and will live their lives "in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ." (Ephesians 4:13b)

CAMP FOUNDER

Stan Daugherty, long time college and high school basketball coach founded the Higher Level Basketball Camps in 1994. The camps originated out of an idea for all campers to "raise their level" during the week of basketball camp. This idea has grown into a series of Higher Level Basketball Camps in which Christian principles serve as the guiding influence in the teaching of life and basketball to all of the participants. Coach Daugherty has coached at every level from middle school to college. Known for his teaching of fundamentals, he has compiled a record of over 200 wins as a head coach at five high schools in Indiana. He has won three sectional championships, two conference championships, three county championships and coached Matt Painter, currently the head coach of Purdue University. As the head coach at Goshen College, he coached the school's first team to win twenty games in a season in more than fifty years of basketball. He had back-to-back twenty-one win seasons from 2003-2005 and was the MCC Coach of the Year in 2005. Coach Daugherty left Goshen College as the all time leader in victories for a head coach in men's basketball. He has been active in the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the Indiana Basketball Coaches Association. Coach Daugherty is currently working as an area rep for FCA in east central Indiana.

COST OF THE CAMP

Admission for the camp is \$350 for a father and a son. An additional son may attend for a cost of \$120. Commuters may attend the camp for only \$250 if they choose to spend overnight at home. Price includes housing, meals, t-shirts and a basketball. A \$100 deposit is requested when you apply.


