Covid Testing

COVID-19 Free Testing Available at Three Sites with No Doctor's Order Required

Appointments: 240-777-1755 (8 am-6 pm)

Montgomery County has three sites where residents can get tested for COVID-19. Testing requires an advance appointment, but doctor's orders are not required and the tests are free.

The test sites will use oral swab tests so the tests are easier and quicker. Results will be issued in approximately 72 hours.

The test site operation hours are:

- Germantown. Parking garage behind the Regal Theaters at 20010 Century Blvd. Mondays from 10 am to 2 pm.
- Wheaton. Montgomery County Parking Garage No. 45 at 11304 Amhurst Ave. Wednesdays and Fridays from 10 am to 2 pm.
- White Oak. Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program site at 2121 Industrial Parkway. Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10 am to 2 pm.

Absentee Voting

It's time NOW to prepare for the November election. Unlike the Maryland primary, registered voters will not automatically receive ballots by mail. **Instead, voters who do not care to vote in person must apply for an absentee ballot**.

Given the likelihood of a heavy response to requests for absentee ballots, all registered voters in Maryland should promptly visit https://elections.maryland.gov/voting/absentee.html. All registered DC voters will receive a ballot by mail.

Financial Assistance

The Hebrew Free Loan Association of Greater Washington (HFLAGW)

HFLAGW provides <u>zero-interest emergency loans</u> up to \$2,500 to Jewish borrowers across the DC metro area who are impacted financially by the Corona virus. These loans can assist with lost wages, rent/mortgage payments, childcare costs, medical expenses and more. Larger loan (up to \$15,000) are also available. You can review the loan guidelines <u>here</u>.

Process: Apply online <u>here</u>. Applications will be reviewed and approved by HFLAGW staff and board. Once approved, documents will be sent to the applicant via DocuSign and loan proceeds will be transferred electronically or sent by check based on borrower preference. Loans will be processed in less than three business days (usually quicker).

Repayments terms: Repayments are \$100/month, beginning the month after the loan is initiated with the option to delay repayments up to three months.
