Welcome

Welcome to Our Mother of Confidence and thank you for considering registering your child in our parish Faith Formation program.

Parents are the first and primary teachers of faith. Through your witness, dedication, habits and traditions your children learn the importance of a relationship with God and the community of the Church. We are here to help you.

The goals of our Faith Formation Program are:

- To invite families to know and love God who knows and loves us completely
- To enable our children to carry on the Catholic faith as disciples and witnesses of Jesus
- To develop a strong sense of belonging to the Catholic Church and to the parish family.
- To teach the importance of service to others as Jesus taught us
- To prepare families and their children to receive the Sacraments

LIVING FAITH

A significant percentage of families only enroll in Faith Formation when a child is preparing for Reconciliation and First Communion then return to prepare for Confirmation.

However, *all children who do not attend a Catholic school should be enrolled in Faith Formation even when not preparing for a Sacrament.*

While we cannot teach faith in 30 hours a year, we can partner with you to provide a practical knowledge of God and His Church, and offer ways to help you enhance your child's belief in and relationship with Jesus Christ.

Our intention is to provide an environment in which families remain tied to practicing and learning their faith and growing in community.

FORMATS

To meet the differing needs of families, we offer Faith Formation in two formats:

[Traditional Catechesis Model](#)

- Children attend weekly class with their peers
- Led by a qualified catechist

[Family Catechesis Model](#)

- Families attend one class a month.
- Parents and children learn together working at home the rest of the month.
- Children will also attend 1 virtual session per month.

[Sacrament Preparation](#)

Preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist is generally a two year process beginning in first grade. However it is never too late to begin.

Sacrament Preparation is in addition to regular attendance in Faith Formation classes. Families will receive a special blessing at Mass as you begin this journey and will have occasional sessions along the way.

Details and dates will be sent home at the beginning of the Faith Formation year.
