## FINANCIAL SERVICES

### EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Emergency Financial Assistance provides support to adult cancer patients by relieving some of their immediate financial concerns. Grants help with basic, non-medical bills such as food, gas, rent or mortgage, and utilities, and can help provide comfort and peace of mind during the overwhelming months following a cancer diagnosis.

### FINANCIAL CANCER CARE

Angel Foundation's Financial Cancer Care program connects cancer patients with a Social Worker and a Pro Bono Certified Financial Planner™ through educational workshops and one-on-one meetings. The goal of the program is to provide a road map for patients to help decrease anxiety about managing finances as they navigate the potentially devastating effects of cancer-related financial toxicity.
