During our outdoor activities, we could observe the green grass and the blue sky, choose between the yellow and green swing, and play with the red ball. The children also enjoyed playing with bubbles and trying to pop them. They are always very busy and enjoy the moment when we take a little break to drink water.

For Art/small group, the children colored with crayons, and made a "mess free" painting by mixing 4 different colors of paint in a plastic bag and they played sorting colors.

As our little ones are entering the wonderful world of Toddlerhood, they are going to face numerous challenges! Indeed, they are going to learn how to socialize and share with their classmates. Also, this year will be the year of language emergence as well as gross motor, fine motor and cognitive development and we are delighted to help them and be there for them in this big adventure.

Our two first weeks went very well (and being honest with a great teacher/child ratio), and we already see some great change in the children. We are looking forward to the upcoming year and are overly excited to work with all of these wonderful and adorable children.
