Dear Parents,

This week, we repeated the same topic as last week: Leaves / Fall and we reviewed the colors red, orange, yellow, green, and brown.

We had fun at the beginning of the week as we went on a "leaves hunt"! We picked up leaves of different sizes and colors and used them for different activities:

Sensory: the children touched dry leaves and fresh leaves to experiment with the difference in texture. They also observed how some leaves turned from green to orange, red, or yellow to brown.

Art: they used the leaves to stick them on contact paper.

Circle Time: as we sang the song "all the leaves are falling down, falling down, falling down, all the leaves are falling down, red, yellow, orange, green and brown", we took some leaves from the bucket and let them fall down or blew them away.

During small group, the children made more projects about Fall: they painted a construction paper using a sponge and 3 different colors (green, red, and yellow), and the teacher cut out a leaf shape. They also practiced scribbling using orange, brown, red, yellow, and green crayons.

For gross motor activities, we practiced walking holding one or two hands: the children walked in the classroom and in the playground. They particularly appreciated walking in the leaves and listening to the crackling sound!

We were happy to welcome last week a new adorable friend: Santino. Now, we have the perfect parity in the classroom: 2 girls and 2 boys! They are learning to know each other and we can observe some parallel play (playing close to each other). Soon the children will learn to play together and to share.
