Hello Parents,

This week we talked about "Winter". The students learned that winter is one of the four seasons of the year. The students shared their thoughts about this season. They learned that is cold and that in some places it snows, and we also talked about animals that live in the snow and what type of clothes we use during winter. We introduced the letter "Ss".

Art: The students made mittens by using construction paper, glue, foam shapes to decorate, and cotton. The students also made a winter tree. We used construction paper, white paint, and glue. On another day the students used white circles with the letters of their names to put them together to make a snowman. Orange Door students also made a winter hat by using construction paper, cotton, glue, and mosaic squares. The children are practicing on how to trace numbers and their name. We are reinforcing the use of scissors to help them learn how to cut properly.

Soccer: The children enjoy their time outside playing soccer and dribbling the ball with Ms. Jackie.
