Dear Parents,

Everyone agreed the best day of this week was Tuesday when we had our Spring Egg Hunt event. The children were very excited and happy to look for the eggs in our playground. Too bad, it was done in a jiffy!

During this week, we talked about the tradition of Easter, the eggs and the Easter bunny. The children took turns sharing with their friends about their egg hunt during the weekend and what they found in the eggs!

The children learned words starting with the letter U: unicycle, unicorn, umbrella, upside down, up, under, underwear, uncle...

This week was also dedicated to enhancing the tracing skill using stencils and learning about the pastel colors and how to make them.

For small/group and Art, the children decorated their bags using different materials: mosaic squares, markers, stickers, and bunny stencil. They decorated their bunny headband with stickers. They traced the letter U using a stencil and colored it. They glued an umbrella shape and dipped one finger in blue paint to make the rain. They mixed paints of their choice with white paint to make pastel colors and painted on paper. Finally, they played with the Play-Doh to create the letter U.

The playground was fun, as they really enjoyed looking for eggs, we hid objects in the playground for them to find; they got a little help from their teachers who told them if they were hot or cold. We also got a new toy kitchen with utensils and food to play with it and keep them very busy.

For Storytime, we read the following stories: "There Was an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Chick", "If I Had a Dragon", "If You Give a Mouse a Cookie", "No Baby Sister Allowed", "Napping House", and "Mrs. Nosh Hangs Up Her Wash."
