We have had a great week learning all about Spring. The children learned that during springtime all the animals hibernating during the Winter, are now waking up and looking for food. They also learned that the Spring season is a time of year when the weather begins to change. It is a transition season between the winter and summer seasons. The days get longer and nights get shorter, the temperature is milder, and flowers bloom. There is a warm wind in the spring season in the air.
