Hello! This week the children learned about Winter. During CircleTime the teacher showed the children pictures of the snow. They were asked if they thought the snow was hot or cold according to the way the children were dressed in the picture. A lot of the children answered correctly and said cold. Also, the teacher asked the children what clothing do they wear when it is cold outside? We heard answers like pants, boots, hand mittens, and a winter hat like the one we did for art this week. During our Circle Time, we learn our colors and shapes as well.

For Art, Snowball painting was lots of fun. The children dipped into white paint a cotton ball to represent the snow. and then onto blue construction paper. The winter hat art craft was lots of fun as well. The children first colored half of a paper plate and then decorated it using mosaic squares and glued a pom-pom to the top tier of the hat. Snowy trees winter craft was also fun. The children were given a tree shape and using their fingertips added the snow by dipping their little fingertips into white paint. Playing with Play-Doh is always a blast, The children love to roll and flatten their Play-Doh and used different winter themed Play-Doh cutters. They also practiced putting together different themed puzzles and played with wild animals, sea animals, and farm animals. As they were playing, the children were asked to put in one bin the sea animals and in the other the farm animals. They did a great job at sorting the animals.

They love to go to the playground and play with their friends and ride the tricycles and play basketball games. But we also practice our gross motor skills. This week we jumped in place, kicked the ball to see who kicked the ball the farthest, rode tricycles, marched around the playground, and ran two laps around the playground.
