Dear Yellow Door's Parents:

This week, your kids learned about the Rainforest. During Circle Time, we moved our bodies, we sang and danced to: Good Morning; ABC; Counting Rock; 7 Days of the Week; Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes; If You are Happy; The Wheels of the Bus; Sticky Bubble Gum; Elevator; BINGO; Old McDonald; Action Song; Listen & move; Freeze Dance; We're going to a Bear Hunt; and Baby Shark.

For Storytime, we read: Jungles (Nature Hide & Seek); Rainforest Wonder, We're Roaming in the Rainforest, Come on into the Rainforest; Discover the Amazon; and, Walking Through the Jungle. After reading, the students visited these areas: Art, Block, Housekeeping, Library, Science and Discovery.

For Art, the children made a snake with colored craft sticks. The students made a monkey by using brown crayons to color a paper plate and glued the eyes and ears to it. The kids made the head of a Toucan with construction paper and different colored crayons. They glued eyes, black stripes, ears and mouth, and colored with orange crayons on the paper plate to create a tiger. The children decorated a circle using mosaic squares and then glued the legs, head, and eyes to create their turtles that were made on construction paper.

At playground time, the kids ran 3 times and they played with balls. The children jumped in place and they played Hide & Seek with the teacher and their friends.

Parents, please wash your child's blanket and return to school nice and clean on Monday. Make sure their nails are cut short so that way they don't scratch themselves or their friends.
