This week the students continued to learn about the first H sounds. CH and WH, to further explore the sounds the students blended words that have the Ch and WH sound in the beginning of the word for example: Chop, White, Champ and Wheel. They also created a ch bag and practiced sounding out the words that have a CH sound. Students also drew a whale in the ocean and practice WH sound.

For writing the students wrote sentences using their sight words. The students were reminded of uppercase letters, finger space and punctuations.

For math, the students learned about analog and digital clocks. We discussed that an analog clock the bigger hand marks minutes (when it is pointed to the 12, it means o'clock) and the short hand identifies the hour.

On a digital clock the hour is shown first and followed by two dots. When they see two zeros that mean o'clock. The students made their own clocks and practiced telling time.

For science the students read the scholastic magazine about arctic animals, how cold weather freezes over ponds and lakes, and eggs which told the students about different animals who lay eggs.
