Dear Parents,

During this week we used skills such as rereading and looking for key details to understand an author's purpose, this strategy helps students comprehend a story better.

For grammar, we worked with CVCe syllables and special articles such as these, that, this, and those; we also reviewed adjectives, synonyms, and antonyms.

We finished Chapter 8 in math, and we started Chapter 9. This chapter is about measurement as well. In this chapter, the students are using smaller units of measurement such as centimeters. This chapter will go quickly as well. It is important that your child is at school every day, unless he or she is sick, because every day missed means a lot of information missed as well!

As for science, the chapter about the states of matter, liquids, gas and solids is very short. The children will be tested on their knowledge sometime next week. Please make sure your child is reinforcing what is learned here at school using their small science books sent home. The vocabulary covered is usually at the end of the book.

During social studies, we reviewed what the constitution is and American symbols. The students wrote a constitution for the class. Please make sure that your child is working on the social studies project/mobile which will be presented and graded next week.

During Spanish, we covered the letter Qq and words say (dice) and go (vamos). The students wrote short sentences using sequence words, such as first (Primero), next (luego), and last (por último). The students are learning a Spanish song that talks about taking care of our planet Earth, and how the children are the future of our world.

Our spring egg hunt was short but sweet. Picking up the eggs was fast, yet the beautiful smiles and giggling in the students' faces is priceless! I am pretty sure they all enjoyed opening their eggs at home. Thank you to all of you who supported us with this activity.
