Dear Parents,

Our topic for this week was "Clothes". We spent time talking about dressing up , the names of clothing items, and where to wear them!

For Art Activities, the children applied stamps on construction paper and the teacher cut them out to make a shirt and paint. They also colored a paper using crayons and chalk of their choice. The teacher cut out different pieces of clothes (shirt, skirt, overalls, pants, socks, underwear etc.) and the next day the children made a collage and "hung" the clothes on a clothesline. To talk more about clothes, during Circle Time, we added 2 more songs to our usual ones such as "This Is the Way I Dress", and "Let's Get Dressed!"

We also read lots of fascinating stories such as, "Fuzzy Bear Gets Dressed" "What Should I Wear?" "Pete the Cat and His White Shoes" and "My First Book of Words Clothes."

During Centers, we played dress-up of course! We have a variety of clothes from dresses, hats, uniforms and more! The children love to watch themselves in the mirror as they try something new.

The playground is always fun, they are now very independent and able to ask for what they want: swing, popping bubbles, going on the slide, playing with a ball and they also learn to take turns with their friends. One important thing at the end of playground time is staying hydrated as we always take time to drink water.
