Dear Parents,

This week, our topic was about "Transportation", The children learned about ways to go from one place to another one; we discussed Land, Air, and Water transportation. We also figured that our feet are also a way of transportation.

During Center time, the children love to play with our transportation toys: trucks and cars, playing also with the train set and assembling the tracks. They build garages for the cars or towers to destroy with the "monster truck".

We also learned about the letter L: Lobster, Lamb, Letter, Leaf, Leader, Line, Lion, Lizard - Thank you by the way for bringing a word every week.

For Art, the children did the following projects: the children traced the letter L and colored inside. They colored the picture of a car, a plane, and a boat printed on paper and cut out each of them. On construction paper, they colored the sky, the sea, and a road and glued the car, the boat, and the plane. They made a traffic light coloring 3 circles in red, yellow, and green; they cut each circle and glued them on black construction paper.

We had another scientific experiment and observed what floats and what sinks. The children liked when we sank a boat adding water to it.

Talking about water, on Monday, the children went to the garden and planted green and red peppers. During playground time, we took the time to take care of our plants and water them. They love this activity and we are going to have a beautiful garden thanks to their hard work!

For storytime we read the following books: My Car, Airport, Boats, Transportation, Little Train, I Love Planes, and I Love Trucks.
