Dear Parents,

First off, we would like to wish Alia from Silver Door 1 and Alfredo from Silver Door 2 a very happy birthday!! We hope you had a wonderful day!

This was a Seuss-tastical week! Some of the books we read were Cat in the Hat, Oh, the Places You'll Go, Fox in Socks, and Horton Hears a Who. We also had a great time dressing up each day and we hope you enjoyed seeing the pictures on Brightwheel.

This week in language arts, our question of the week was "What can help you get from here to there?" Our vocabulary words were transportation, vehicle, wide, fierce, and journey. We made a web using the different types of vehicles we use to travel. This week we wrote a story that had a beginning, middle, and an end using their choice of vehicle. Our story of the week was 'When Daddy Picks Me Up.' This was a cute story about a child that is excited to have his dad pick him up in a truck. Our letters of the week were Jj and Qq. Students learned that qu are best friends and work together to make a sound. Our sight words of the week were here and me. Every week we read short stories that have a lot of familiar words and each week students are becoming great independent readers with a lot of confidence. Keep practicing at home! Next week we will finish the final two letters of the alphabet.

In math, we finished with Chapter 9. We compared two-dimensional shapes using the words alike and different. Students compared the amount of sides and vertices each of the four shapes have. We also learned how to draw to join shapes to make new shapes and see how many shapes fit into other shapes. For example, 6 triangles fit into an octagon. Students were given different pattern block to make new drawings or shapes. Finally, we had our review test and our real test on Friday. Next week we will start with Chapter 10, three-dimensional shapes.
