In Language Arts and Reading, our essential question was, "How do people help out in the community?". This week was all about how we can help our community like growing a garden, picking up trash, recycling, and helping when someone is in trouble. Our sounds this week were: th, sh, and ending -ng like in with, ship, and sing. The students also learned about common and proper nouns. Common is when it starts with a lowercase letter and Proper is a specific name and it starts with a capital. Our story of the week was, "The Story of Martin Luther King Jr", which was about Martin Luther King Jr and the difference he wanted to make.

In Math, we finished Chapter 4. This week the students learned that they can use an addition problem to help them solve a subtraction problem.
