Dear Parents,

Our topic for this week was "Weather" and the letter W. During Circle Time, we reviewed the 4 seasons and learned about different types of weather. The children talked about their favorite weather and explained why. Some like summer because they are going to the beach and enjoyed sunny days. Some like the rain because you put on your rain boots, raincoat, and umbrella and play in the puddles. Some like snowy days when you can build a snowman and others like windy days so they can fly a kite. The children learned that during stormy days, you need to stay inside for safety.

The children took turns guessing or saying a word starting with the letter W; weather, whale, walrus, wheel, watermelon, why, wonderful, wet, and much more.

We read books explaining the different seasons and weather such as: Weather and Season, What is Weather?, Bear Feels Scared, and Stormy Day.

For our projects/small group, the children traced the letter W and colored it in red to make a watermelon. They made a collage using shapes of sun, clouds, and rain. They traced the shape of a kite and colored and decorated it. Finally, they practiced writing their name and the letter W and rolled Play-Doh to make letters.
