Dear Parents,

This week we learned all about the weather! During Circle Time, we encouraged the children to look at the window to see "what the weather is like today" as we sing the song and mimic the weather: Wind: we blow and move our arms side to side. Rain, we wiggle our fingers from the top to the bottom. Sun: we make a big circle in the air.

We also sang "rain, rain go away" and it's raining, it's pouring".

This week for Music Class, the children enjoyed playing with the steel drum using a mallet.
