Dear Parents of Yellow Door,

This week children learned all about "Wild Animals".

In morning Circle Time. the children sang and danced to "Good Morning, ABC's, Days of the Week, Lion Hunt, etc."

I also introduced the wild animals by showing them some animals toys, described by colors, sizes, and sounds.

During Center Time, students had a lot of fun by pretending they were in the jungle by acting like their favorite animal. Also, they visited different areas like art, blocks, housekeeping, library, and table tops.

In Art Time the children worked hard doing animals prints, with construction paper, paint, and animal figurines. They made a paper plate giraffe, paper plate tiger, with orange tissue paper, black construction paper stripes and a mosaic lion in their journals, a paper plate elephant with crayon, glue and eyes.

As a Gross Motor activity children worked on kicking balls, throwing balls, jumping in place, ran 2 laps in the playground and free play.

In Story Time we read "Llama, Llama Mad Mama, No More Diapers For Ducky, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Reptiles, and Hands Are Not For Hitting".

We also worked on reinforcement, the children learned how to count 1-10, make shapes with hands, recognize colors, and letters of their names.
