This week we discussed the essential question: How do our senses help us learn? To further explore we read the story *Senses By The Seashore* which told the students about the different senses used at the beach. We also read the story *a feast of senses* about a family cooking different foods while using their senses. While reading the students were introduced to new vocabulary words such as feast, knead, finished, senses, and explore.

For writing the students learned about the 'at ' family as well as the letter /s/. They also wrote about a time when they used all their senses.

For math, we discussed the numbers 1-8 and learning to write and identify each number using a tens frame

For social studies, the students learned about courage and bravery. They learned about Martin Luther King Jr. and Harriet Tubman and how their bravery helped many people.
