Dear Parents,

During this week we worked with "commas in a series" and "nouns." We also worked with the short and long sound of letter O. The students are working with "descriptive details." They are encouraged to identify those in the stories read to support their findings (what is the plot, what is the setting, the problem? was it solved?) as well as using them in their writing tasks. Encourage your child to look for details when you read together.

For Math, we started Chapter 3 this week, we covered "Double Facts" and "Addition Facts."

I introduced some Science vocabulary words and we discussed what -to infer- means. We found out that most of the students in Silver 2 are right-handed and that one student is ambidextrous.

For Social Studies, we finished talking about maps and how to find places on Earth.
