We did a fun art activity and played a matching game. Our sight words were the number words one through ten.

In math, we felt it was important to review different addition concepts. We practiced the ten partners, using part/part/whole to find the missing additive, and teen numbers. We reviewed the words sum, plus, addition sentence, ten frame, and counters. Then we reviewed the subtraction, minus, and is equal to. We used different shapes, clips, and cubes, to help us find the answers. Then we reviewed the numbers 11-20.

In science we had a fun time reading some wonderful magazines. We learned how to make bubbles and test it out. We learned how animals can communicate by using different sounds or body movement. We learned how hermit crabs love and how they change their homes based on their size. Finally, we went over how to stay safe in the summer time.
