During this week we worked with skills such as commas in a series, nouns, and prefixes. The students practiced these skills using their textbook "Your Turn," "worksheets," "the whiteboard" and while "playing."

The Essential Question this week was "How do animals survive?" We read and discussed stories such as "Sleds Dogs Run," "Cold Dog, Hot Fox" and "Swamp Life." We reviewed the characteristics of a Realistic Fiction story.

For math, we covered lessons 3.3 and 3.4. The students needed extra practice with the "make a ten strategy," you may want to encourage your child to practice some more at home (Lesson 3.3, see homework packet).

We visited our amazing garden this week and the children planted some squash, we will visit our garden during the week to see how our plants are doing.

We had an in-house field trip, our special guest shared a lot of interesting information about the yellow footed tortoise, alligators, crocodiles and other reptiles! The students were able to pet some of those fantastic creatures!
