Dear Parents of Kindergarten Students;

I hope that you had a wonderful week!

This week the children learned under the topic; What do living things need to grow? The vocabulary words were; require, plant, harmful, soak, and crowd. The letter of the week was; H and they learned the sounds and words that begin with the same sound like; helicopter, hand, head, horse, and house. We also blended sounds to make words that begin with the /h/ sound. Words like; hot, hat, ham, hid, hit, hip, hop, him, and had. The new sight word was; "my". The children read it, spelled it, and wrote sentences using this word. This week the children learned about plurals during grammar. They identified the noun in sentences and then changed it to plural by adding "s" at the end of the word.

During math we began Chapter 7 where the children will be learning about representing, counting, and writing numbers 11-19. On Monday and Tuesday, they learned how to write numbers 11 and 12. They also learned how to model them with cubes, objects, and counters on the ten frame.

This week we continued with science where they learned how to use our senses to observe and describe objects. They learned that with their eyes they can tell the color, size, and shape of an object. We also learned that with the sense of touch, they can describe how an object feels and we learned the words rough and smooth. On Thursday they learned that objects can weigh differently. We used a scale to weigh different objects and went over the words; "heavy and light".

This week we also began rehearsing for our Christmas Caroling which is next Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. The children are putting in the maximum effort to make this a memorable time that you as parents can enjoy. We hope to see you on Wednesday.
