Dear Parents,

This week we celebrated Dr. Seuss as our social studies part! We read so many different books and did fun writing and drawing activities. This is one of our favorite weeks because we celebrate the whole week. I hope you have enjoyed the pictures.

This week in unit 5.2 we talked about the things we can see in the sky. Our vocabulary is observe, vast, certain, remained, and thoughtful. We read a couple of fantasy stories titled, 'Fern the Bird' and 'Kitten's First Full Moon.' In these stories, we discussed the cause and effect the characters go through. We also indemnified our sight and spelling words. Our spelling words have the

r-controlled vowels /er/, /ir/, /ur/, and /or/. They learned that the letter r sound takes over the vowel. We also learned about the ending -er changing a verb into a noun. For example, teach+er=teacher.

In Math, we continued with Chapter 9. We learned how to add two-digit numbers without regrouping and breaking apart the tens and ones. We discussed how important it is to draw a quick picture to find the answer, although some kids can do it in their heads. We also quickly touched on subtracting two-digit numbers. If you feel that your child is struggling...it's important to review simple addition and subtracting facts. Next week we will finish Chapter 9.
