This week, we were reviewing our classics as the theme was “Nursery Rhymes” and the children enjoyed this topic very much!

We read, sang or listened to all the good classics such as “Humpty Dumpty”, “Twinkle Twinkle Little Star”, “Itsy, Bitsy Spider”, “Mary Had A Little Lamb” and many other ones. Most of the children are now able to do the gestures to go with the songs or to clap along.

The children had fun playing Humpty Dumpty, pretending to sit on a wall (teacher laps) and having a great fall. Luckily, they had a happier ending as we can put all the children together again! This week, we also introduced to the children how to play "Ring Around The Rosie", holding hands and going round and round.

For art, the children pasted tissue papers a construction paper to reinforce their grasping fine motor (PINCE GRASP) and hand-eye coordination. . They also painted a carton tube, rolling it in different color of paints.

During Music Class with Ms. Clarice, the children could play with 2 different music instruments: the tambourine and the cabasa, a small instrument that you roll. At the end of Music Class, they liked to listen to the sound of the "ocean drum", a drum filled with little bead; when you move the drum, just close your eyes and you are right at the beach, relaxing listening to the sound of the waves!
