Dear Parents of Kindergarten Students,

At Kindergarten the children learned under the theme: "How do tools help us explore?" in Language Arts. They also learned the letter P, its sound, and words that begin with the same letter. This week they learned that some words can also end with this letter and we identified words that end with the /p/ sound like; gap, map, sap, mop, soup, and soap. The new sight word was; "a" which the children read sentences like; I see a deer, I see a horse and I see a tiger. During reading, we read stories that were informational text and one that was a tale told long ago in Japan. The stories were about tools that we use to help get the job done. We had vocabulary words; tool, fetch, discover, rumble, and defeated. In Grammar, they are learning about verbs. They learned that verbs are action words in the sentences. We identified verbs in sentences like; The teacher talks, The children play.

During Math, we continued counting and writing numbers 8 and 9. They learned how to make 8 and 9 using different color counters and the 10 frames. We also went over making sets of 8 and 9 and solving problems with 9.

In Science, they learned about the topic of Weather. The children learned how to observe patterns in the weather to record what the weather was like every day. The vocabulary words were; sunny, windy, cloudy, and rainy. On Friday we did a small experiment to learn about hot, and cold temperatures by reading the thermometer.

It was a really busy week and on Friday we went to the garden with Mrs. Martha to plant tomatoes. The children were happy to be able to go to the garden!
