This week our question of the week was "What do friends do together?" Our vocabulary words were relationship, cooperative, deliver, chore, and collect. Our big book was "Friends All Around". Our vowel of the week was the short o sound. We reviewed the plural -s, the blending of the l, and some review of older words. We also went into detail about doing alphabetical (ABC) order. Our sight words were fun, make, they, too. Some of the stories we read were "Friends" and "Toss! Kick! Hop!" The students are getting better at identifying the key details in a story and finding the author's purpose for their writing. We also identified the correct time to use a question mark or exclamation mark.

In Math, we continued with Chapter 3. We learned how to add doubles using cubes and doubles plus one and minus one. We used the strategies we learned like counting on and number lines to find the answer. Then we reviewed add 10 and more. We still have one more week of Chapter 3.

In Science, we reviewed our lesson on living and non-living. This time we dove into plants and what parts of a plant help the plant grow. We saw a picture of a Lobster Claw plant. Some words we heard and read are flower, fruit, root, leaves, seed, and stem. We saw a video describing different plants and what different flowers do.
