For the past week, the children traveled to Argentina. They danced to the rhythm of Tango music and listened to nursery rhyme songs in Argentina. This week for art, we used blue and yellow Do-A-Dot markers and crayons.

During the day we listened to our good morning songs which the children love, sing, and dance to. On the floor mat, we practiced our leg workouts by moving our legs up and down.
