Hello! This week we talked about "Hanukkah" and the celebration of the Festival of Lights. The children learned the importance of giving and sharing during this time as well as some symbols of this holiday. Some of those symbols include the Menorah, the Dreidel, and the Star of David. The children practiced sorting Legos by color and took turns sharing words that begin with letters A-H.

For art, the children showed off their skills by decorating a menorah and gluing candles to make a beautifully lit menorah. They also used blue paint popsicle sticks and glitter to decorate their own Star of David and used stencils, crayons, and tissue paper to decorate a dreidel. We practiced writing the letter A-H all on our own and enjoyed some time working on our journals.

For Storytime, we read Hanukkah: A Counting Book, Hanukkah Oh Hanukkah, Sadie and the Snowy Day, Mrs. Greenberg's Messy Hanukkah, and Numbers: Stop, Look and Learn.
