Dear Parents of Gold and Orange Door,

This week we began our journey by traveling to the continent of Africa. We learned about and made traditional African Masks, learned traditional dances and learned about different foods, and even discussed different safari animals.

During the STEM activity, the students were able to learn about chain reactions and practiced making different tracks each day. They were able to put pieces together and work out the chain reaction. They enjoyed making and learning about how things react because of other reactions.

In Gold Door, the students read two stories every day during Story Time, ranging from "The Class Trip" by Grace Maccarone to "Footprints in the Snow" by Cynthia Benjamin. In "Footprints in the Snow", the children were able to discuss different animals and how they protect themselves. In "The Class Trip" the children also learned about different animals and how to stay safe during a field trip, always remaining close to your class.

In Orange Door, the students read two stories every day during Story Time, ranging from "I Can Read With My Eyes Shut" by Dr. Seuss, to "Cat in the Hat" by Dr. Seuss. The students were able to interact with and ask questions about the story as a whole group and practice their listening skills.

The students played soccer with Coach Jackie, practicing and refining their skills, as well as practicing other games.
