Dear Gold Door Parents,

This week we discussed the essential question: How is everyone special? To further explore this topic we read the story Animals In the Park an ABC book to discuss different animals and the alphabet. We also read the story The Ugly Ducking about a duckling who was born different and wasn't treated very nicely. The students practiced letter A-G, we reviewed the sound each letter makes, writing upper and lowercase. For writing, the students wrote sentences using "I" such as I am a boy or I have brown hair.

For social studies, the students learned the vocabulary words such as Timeline and Calendar. We also discussed Why do we go to school? They were introduced to our class calendar. We explained the year 2021 and how birthdays happen once a year. As well, we discussed how people change over time by asking the students what they think they looked like as a baby and how our appearance changes as we grow.

For math, the students reviewed counting 1-5, they also practiced writing their numbers and showing numbers 1-5. The students practiced counting different objects such as cubes, counters, pencils, and writing the amount.
