

Dear Parents,

This week we are beginning a new theme in our classroom, "Creative Me". The topic this week is "Under Construction". Children love to watch construction work. They are fascinated by big machines. This week, children will explore construction. They will learn the names of construction vehicles and how they are used. They will also be introduced to the different stages (steps) in building. The students learned that construction is the process of building something. Use the Word of the Week at home. You might notice a construction project and discuss the machines you see: Look at the cement mixer. What do you think these workers are building?

Letters we reviewed this week: Cc, Ii, Rr

We introduced these letters and listened to the sound that they make through different songs. We learned that Ii is a vowel. During Circle Time, the students came up with words that start with these letters. We reinforced how to make the letters with stencils and traced them on dry-erase sheets. We practiced tracing and coloring the letters, wrote words that start with these letters and drew pictures.

For Math, the children focused on naming, describing, and analyzing shapes with straight lines. We asked the children to build a shape, then asked questions like: How many sides does your shape have? Are the sides straight? parallel? How can you change the shape? Does your shape have a name? What is it? The children worked in their journals and used the different shapes to make different buildings, skyscrapers, bridges, etc., they imagined they would construct. You can continue to practice building and naming more shapes at home.
