Dear Parents,

This week we discussed the essential question: What can help you get from here to there. To further explore this topic we read When Daddy's Truck Picks Me Up which tells a story of a little boy waiting for his dad to pick him up from school. We also read the King of the Wind about four men traveling home on a boat. Dad got a Job that told the students about a daughter helping her dad pack for his new job at the boating dock. While reading these stories the student learned new vocabulary such as vehicle, transportation, wide, journey, and fierce. The students also were introduced to the letters Jj and Qq practicing the letter sounds and different words that are made with those letters. For writing the students wrote about their favorite kind of transportation.

Math: The students describe, identify and name triangles, rectangles and hexagons. We practiced making shapes with Play-Doh and finding items that are similar to the shapes they learned about. I explained that each shape has a different number of sides and vertices. The Mid-Chapter Checkpoint was this week as well.

For Science: The students were introduced to sound and how vibrations create sound. They listened to different sounds with their eyes closed explaining to the students that our senses help us to see, hear and feel sound. The experiment this week with a tuning fork showed what sound looks like.
