We hope you all had a wonderful long weekend. It was nice seeing everyone back and ready to keep learning.

Tuesday was our Spring Egg Hunt day. First, thank you to all the parents that offered to help with the eggs. The children were very excited to go to the playground to find all those colorful eggs. When we went back to class, they counted all their eggs. They also sorted the eggs by colors and compared which color had more and which one had less. We posted pictures on Brightwheel and also on Facebook.

The topic of the week was: Transportation. We divided the topic into three sections: Air, Land, and Water. We used this topic to talk about safety, using seat belts while in the car, helmets when riding a bike or tricycle, look both ways before crossing the street, etc.

During Academic Enrichment, the children practiced their fine motor skills by tracing, cutting, and coloring a plane, a car, and a submarine. We counted all the cars in our Block Area a total of 59 and sorted them by colors. We then raced them to see which one would go the farthest. In Block Area, they used the wooden blocks to build bridges and tunnels for the cars.
