Dear Parents of Gold Door,

This week we discussed the essential question: What rules do we follow in different places? To further explore this topic we read the story *How Do Dinosaurs Go To School?* which told the students the different rules even a dinosaur should follow when attending school. We also read the story *When the Boy Cried Wolf* which shared with the class what happens when someone doesn't follow the rules. While reading the students were introduced to new vocabulary such as rule, cooperate, guard, prank, and responsible.

We also introduced the vowel i. Not only did we learn about words that begin with i, we learned about words that have i as their middle sound. Our word family was the -it family. Together we came up with a list of rules we follow in the library and when we cross the street.

In math, we finished Chapter 4. We practiced counting sets of objects and writing the number. We also reviewed the words greater than and less than. This helped us compare two numbers and identify the counting order. We completed our Chapter 4 test on Wednesday.
