Dear Parents,
Welcome back to Silver Door 2nd Grade!

This week the students created, during Social Studies, a journal called "All About Me." They will continue to work on it throughout the year. The first page is a portrait of themselves with some basic information, then they added a page per day. One of the pages includes a group picture of the first day.

For Language Arts, we covered the Genres of Fables and Expository Text. The students were able to tell some characteristics about each genre (literature category). We went over 20 sight words that they should know by now. The homework was about recognizing these words and knowing how to use them in a sentence. The Essential Question for this week was "How are you special?" We discussed this topic, and the students wrote about it. The students wrote their own fable, then they read it to their classmates.

During math, we worked with basic numbers, recognizing even versus odd numbers and representing even numbers using drawings.

This week was about getting acquainted with our new schedule, the rules to follow, how the behavior chart works (it is all about making the right choices!), our new jobs; etc.
